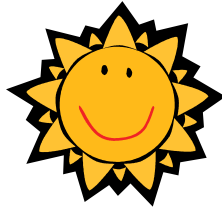

POOL RULES



GENERAL POOL RULES

- No one is admitted without payment or season pass.
- **Pool patrons are responsible for their own actions as well their children's actions.**
- The wading pool is limited to children six years old or younger, those under 42" tall, or children unable to use the pool by themselves. Users of the wading pool must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times. **The inflatable and water toys are property of the Clifton Pool and are not to be removed from the wading pool area.**
- The pool is **not** responsible for loss of or damage to personal property of any kind.
- **The pool manager and/or lifeguards have the authority to close the pool during inclement weather.**
- The pool manger and/or lifeguards may refuse entry in cases of overcrowding or for any safety issue that may arise.

HEALTH RULES

- Food and beverages are to be consumed in designated areas only. **ONLY** plastic bottles of water are allowed in the pool area. Please place garbage in trash cans.
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal substances are prohibited.
- **NO** smoking, vaping, or e-cigarettes are allowed inside the fenced area of the pool or the concession stand.
- Clean and proper swimming attire is required. No cut-offs, nudity, or thongs are allowed. **NO** undergarments are allowed to be worn as a swimsuit.
- **NO** plain diapers are allowed. **Infants and toddlers must wear tight fitting rubber pants or swim diapers.**
- No gum, spitting, or blowing noses in the pool.
- Turn off showers and flush toilets after use. Please report any problems to a staff member.
- Lifeguards may deny admittance to anyone who has skin abrasions, inflamed eyes, contagious skin rashes, infection, or who is wearing bandages.
- No pets or animals are allowed.

DIVING BOARD RULES

- One person at a time on the board.
- Diver may make only one approach and one bounce per dive.

- Divers may **NOT** do sit-drop or inward dives.
- Dive/jump **STRAIGHT** off of the board.
- The diving well must be cleared before using the diving board.
- Divers may not wear eyewear or goggles when diving.
- Hanging from the board is **NOT** allowed.
- No somersaults, cartwheels or other acrobatic stunts are allowed.
- Do not swim directly under the board.
- Use of the diving board may be discontinued at any time at the discretion of the lifeguard.

SAFETY RULES

- Swimmers must stay off the rope marking the deep end.
- Pool ladders are for entering/exiting the pool, do not linger or play on them.
- No bikes, roller blades, scooters, or skateboards are allowed in the pool/concession area.
- **NO** flotation devices are allowed in the big pool.
- The big pool will have an adult swim/break time 10 minutes every hour. Everyone under the age of 18 must exit the pool during this time (this excludes infants/toddlers with parents.)
- Diving is permitted only in designated areas. **NO** diving in the shallow end.

POOL BEHAVIOR

- Running, rough housing, ball playing, or any undue disturbance in and about the pool is not permitted and will not be tolerated. Fighting will result in immediate removal from the pool.
- No dunking or throwing of people in the pool or throwing/pushing of people into the pool.
- Climbing on the poles, fences, trash receptacles, guard chairs, pool furniture, etc., is prohibited.
- **The use of abusive, offensive or profane language/gestures is grounds for immediate ejection from the pool.**
- Public displays of affection in or out of the water are **NOT** allowed.

DISCIPLINARY POLICY

- 1ST offense > > > warning by lifeguard
- 2nd offense > > > sitting out of the pool for 15 minutes
- 3rd offense > > > ejection from the pool complex for remainder of the whole day (or longer if deemed necessary)

The above rules have been made so that pool patrons can enjoy the safe use of our pool. The pool manger and lifeguards are responsible for the strict enforcement of these rules and regulations. PLEASE RESPECT BOTH THE RULES AND THE STAFF. Refusal to comply with any of the above rules or regulations can result in the suspension of pool privileges.
