Inclement Weather Opening/Closing Guidelines

The pool may not open if the following conditions exist:

- Current or forecasted temperature for Clifton is below 68°
- Moderate to heavy rain
- Visible lightning or thunder

The pool will close when two or more of these conditions exist:

- Current air temperature is 70° or below
- Moderate to heavy rain
- Visible lightning or thunder
- A severe weather warning has been issued
- Low attendance (when attendance at the pool is 10 patrons or fewer for 30 minutes)

Inclement Weather Policies:

Rain/Wind:

Heavy rain can make it difficult to see the bottom of the pool or beneath the surface. If heavy rain causes bottom obstruction, the pool will be cleared until the rain lets up. Wind can also cause safety hazards. If wind is observably strong or gusty and causes bottom obstruction due to rippling, swimmers will be cleared from the pool until the bottom is visible.

Thunder/Lightning:

The pool must be cleared of all swimmers at the first clap of thunder or lightning, or any other dangerous weather condition. The pool must remain cleared for **30 minutes** after the **last** clap of thunder or lightning. If the weather worsens the pool area must be vacated. If the pool is closed for more than one hour due to weather conditions, we reserve the right to close for the day.

While closing the pool for any reason is an inconvenience, keeping you safe should NEVER come secondary and is always our priority.

Refunds will be given if patron(s) has only been at the pool for less than one hour.
